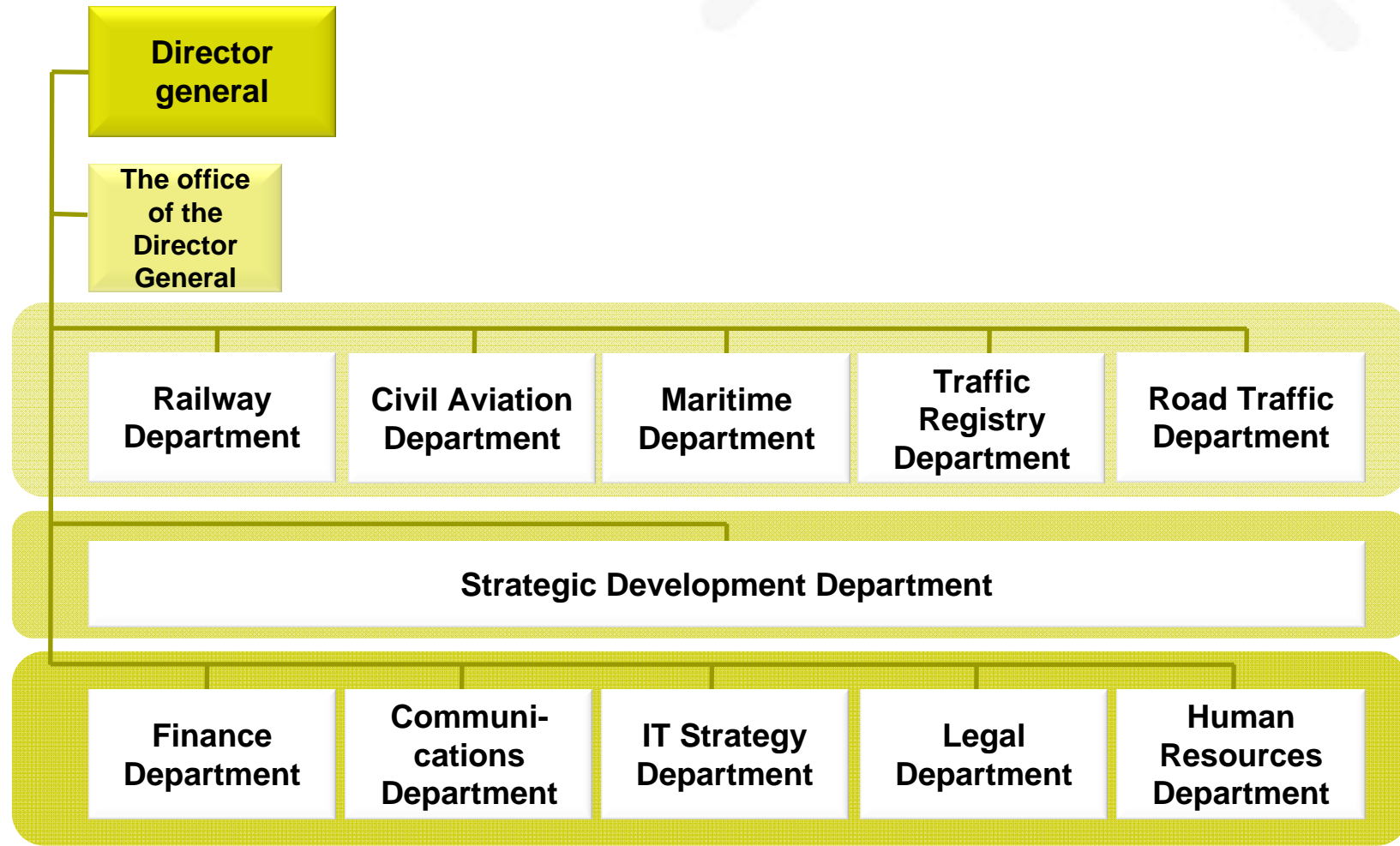

We develop an available transport system, while considering safety, environment and health. We draft rules and check that they are observed, with respect for the consequences for citizens and businesses. We provide society with information about means of transport and drivers. We work with a wide perspective and efficiency, and maintain a high service level in contact with our environment.

Motivated, coherent and reliable

The Railway Department

formulates regulations, examines and grants permits, as well as exercising supervision within the field of railway, light rail and underground systems. Working to achieve a high level of security and an efficient railway market characterized by healthy competition.

Civil Aviation Department

formulates regulations, examines and grants permits, as well as assessing civil aviation with particular regard to safety and security. Also monitor developments in the aviation market.

The Maritime Department

formulates regulations, examines and grants permits, as well as exercising supervision principally of Swedish and foreign vessels sailing in Swedish waters. Also working for improve maritime safety and environmental influence for recreational boating.

The Traffic Registry Department

administers and develops the road traffic registry, which supplies society with information about vehicles, driving licenses and commercial transport. Also operate the congestion charge system.

The Development Department

conducts operations spanning in all forms of transport, and is responsible for strategic operational development, analysis of the outside world and issues relating to human factors as well as crisis management, security and protection. We are also responsible for aspects of the Swedish Transport Agency's sectoral responsibility for aviation issues.

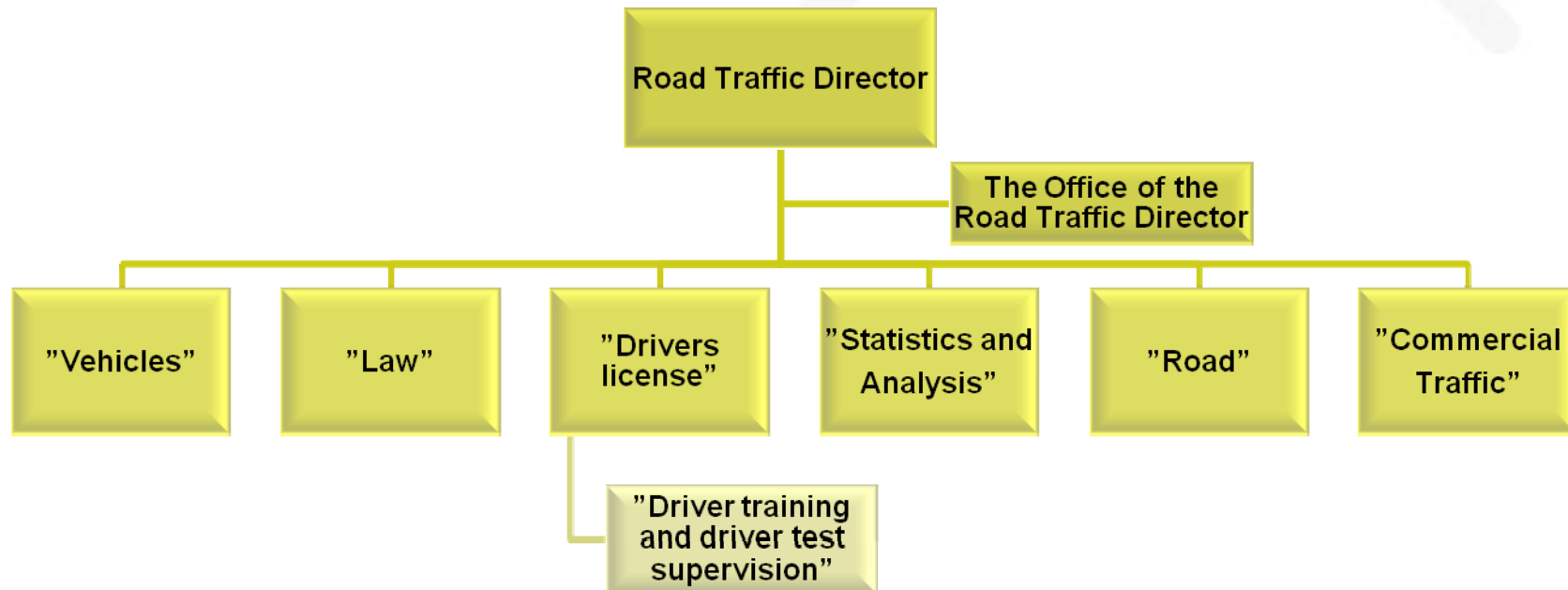
The Road Traffic Department

formulates regulations, examines and grants permits, as well as exercising supervision within the field of road transport over e.g. road traffic, vehicles, driving licenses and commercial transport. Also conduct analyses of road traffic and supply information about injuries and accidents within the road transport system.

Three main tasks

- Formulate regulations
- Examine and grant permits
- Exercising supervision

The role of Statistics and Analysis within the Road Traffic Departement

- Work based on the Political objectives for the road transport system and the mechanisms which have an impact on the achievement of these objectives
- *Follow up and evaluate* if the work RTD do or intend to do have a positive impact on these objectives
- Act as *an auditor and "strategical force"* within the RTD

- Describe different causes or mechanisms which influence different goals/conditions
- Suggest appropriate solutions

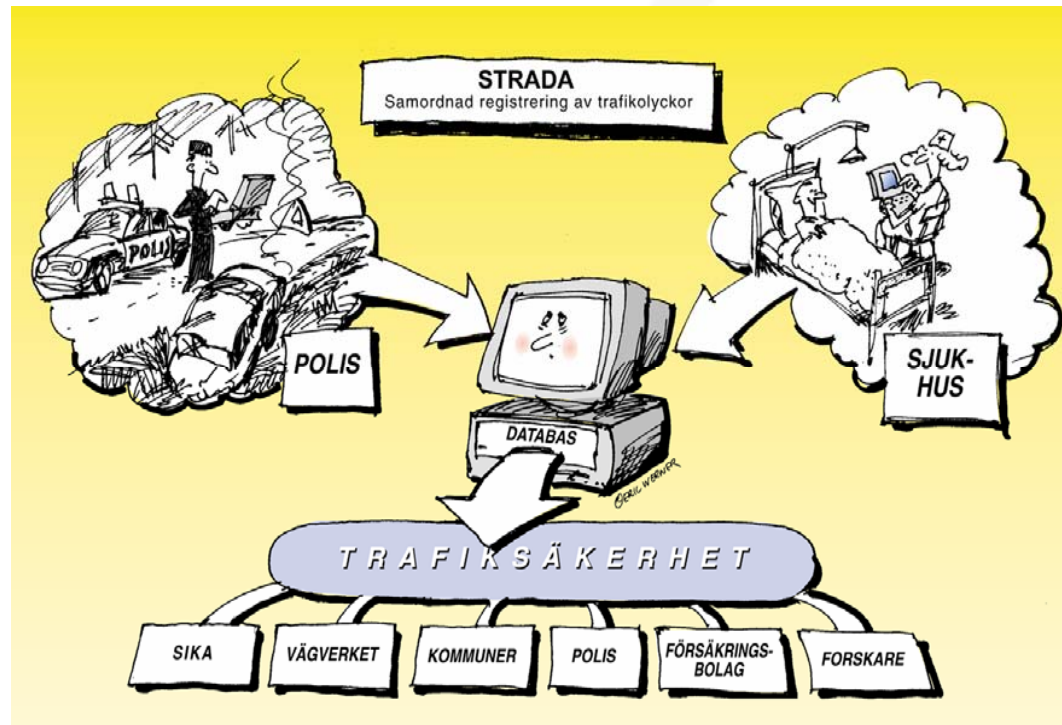
The challenge for Statistics and Analysis

- Develop approaches which can implement results from the unit in to RTD
